And going into one of the ships that was Simon's, He desired him to draw back a little from the land. And sitting, He taught the multitudes out of the ship. Now when He had ceased to speak, He said to Simon: "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a draught." And Simon answering said to Him: "Master, we have labored all the night and have taken nothing: but at Thy word I will let down the net." And when they had done this, they enclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net broke. And they beckoned to their partners that were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came and filled both the ships, so that they were almost sinking.

Which when Simon Peter saw, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying: "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." For he was wholly astonished, and all that were with him, at the draught of the fishes which they had taken. And so were also James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were Simon's partners. And Jesus said to Simon: "Fear not: from henceforth thou shalt catch men." And having brought their ships to land, leaving all things, they followed Him.



St. John the Baptist was born through the intercession of God to Zachariah and Elizabeth, who was otherwise too old to bear children. According to scriptures, the Angel Gabriel visited Elizabeth and Zachariah to tell them they would have a son and that they should name him John. Zachariah was skeptical and for this he was rendered mute until the time his son was born and named John, in fulfillment of God's will.

When Elizabeth was pregnant with John, she was visited by Mary, and John leapt in her womb. This revealed to Elizabeth that the child Mary carried was to be the Son of God.

John began public ministry around 30 AD, and was known for attracting large crowds across the province of Judaea and around the Jordan River. When Jesus came to him to be baptized, John recognized him and said, "It is I who need baptism from you." Jesus told John to baptize Him anyway, which he did, whereupon the heavens opened, and the Spirit of God was seen like a dove. The voice of God spoke, saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

John's attitude toward Jesus was: "He must increase; I must decrease." John instructed his followers to turn to Christ, calling Him the "Lamb of God" and these people were among the first Christians.

Following his baptism of Christ, John's popularity grew so much that he alarmed King Herod. Herod ordered him arrested and imprisoned. John spoke with Herod on several occasions and condemned his marriage to his half-brother's wife.

This condemnation would be his downfall as King Herod promised to grant a wish to his daughter. In revenge for John the Baptist's condemnation of her mother's scandalous marriage to Herod, she asked for John's head. King Herod reluctantly obliged.



The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul is a liturgical feast in honor of the martyrdom in Rome of the apostles Saint Peter and Saint Paul, which is observed on 29 June. The celebration is of ancient Christian origin, the date selected being the anniversary of either their death or the translation of their relics.

The Feast is almost entirely devoted to St. Peter, the Bishop of Rome. St. Paul, the great apostle of the Gentiles is more especially honored on 30 June.

After the Descent of the Holy Ghost, St. Peter preached the Gospel in Judea and was cast into prison by Herod. He was miraculously delivered by an angel and established his See first at Antioch, and then, finally at Rome.

Like St. Paul, he died at Rome during the persecution of Nero (64-68), by being crucified head downward.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

MALE SELF-DESTRUCTION I

My training and interest since high school has been in philosophy and theology—and I'm sure this will not come as a surprise to you. So if the need arises, it is necessary to seek out others who have expertise in areas that may tangentially touch upon these disciplines, but are a subject matter unto themselves.

Recently, I came upon a man who declares his commodity to be that of "life coach." Well, this sounded suspicious to me, so I approached with caution. But after having watched some of his YouTube videos, I thought the content he put forward should gain some attention, seems Biblically based, and for that reason alone worth consideration. His name is Sean Isaacs, and his approach centers around the following ideas:

Most businesses in America fail at a rate of 90% or more in the first ten years. Largely because men (we will confine our discussion presently to men) fail to slay what he terms GIANTS in their lives that will destroy "themselves, their wealth and their relationships." This happens especially to what he calls "high achieving men." These poisonous offshoots are:

[A] Unrighteous ANGER
